In order to perform this update, the following items are needed:

- Pioneer In-Dash AV receiver listed above.
- A USB storage device meeting the following requirements:
 - 2 GB or larger in capacity, formatted to FAT32
 - Blank (should not contain any files)

CAUTION

- **DO NOT** turn your unit off or eject the USB storage device while the firmware is being updated.
- You can only update the firmware when the vehicle is stopped and the parking brake is engaged.

Checking the firmware version


Check whether the firmware of your unit needs to be updated by checking the version number of the firmware.







- DO NOT perform this firmware update if the model number of your Pioneer product is anything other than one of the above models.
- Ensure that the update file is located within the root (top) folder of your USB storage device. There should be no other files within the USB storage device.
- While your unit is being updated, DO NOT turn off the system's power and DO NOT touch the unit's touchscreen as this may result in severe damage to your unit.
- DO NOT remove the USB storage device during the firmware update process.
- Performing the firmware update will restore all settings to their default values.
- Disconnect any external mobile devices that are currently connected to your unit.

Procedure:

- 1. Connect a blank (formatted with FAT32) USB storage device to your computer, and then locate the correct update file and copy it onto the USB storage device.
- 2. Connect the USB storage device to the USB port.
- 3. Touch [MPEG].

Tip: The update screen appears when the vehicle is stopped and the parking brake is engaged. If the update screen does not appear even when parked, return to step 1 and check if the update file was copied to the root (top) folder of the USB storage device correctly.

6. The product will reboot after the update is finished. Do not touch anything even when the screen is blacked out. After it has finished rebooting, the screen will return to the Radio screen.







7. Disconnect the USB storage device, then touch the following key.


